- Know the Muslim core beliefs

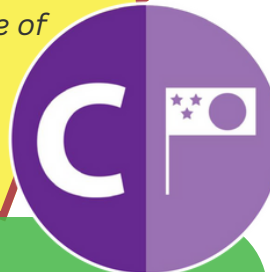
