Dear Parents,

To tie in with our new topic this term, 'Africa', we have arranged to take the children to Woburn Safari Park in Bedfordshire. The children will have a guided safari tour around the park, have the opportunity to get up close with some of the other animals on the walk-through, experience the on-foot safari and also take part in an African adventure outdoor session where they will learn about Rothschild's giraffe and other animals in their Savannah habitat.

The trip will take place on **Thursday 5th December**. Children will need to arrive at school **promptly at 8:45 am** via the usual route, ready for a **9:15am departure**. We will arrive back at school at approximately **3pm** so pick up at the end of the day will take place as usual.

Children should arrive at school in **full school uniform**, with the exception of school shoes, where we recommend that trainers or something comfortable for walking around should be worn. Please also make sure that your child has a warm coat with them as I imagine by then, it could be a bit chilly!

Please send your child in on this day with a snack, packed lunch and drink (which does not leak) in a small rucksack which they will be able to carry themselves on their back. They will not need to bring any other items at all!

We would be very grateful if any parents/carers who would also like to volunteer and kindly help support us with the trip on the day could please let us know asap, thank you.

We are very much looking forward to the trip and think that it will be a fantastic and enjoyable experience for the children!
