- are interested in exploring, understanding and showing respect for different faiths and cultural diversity.



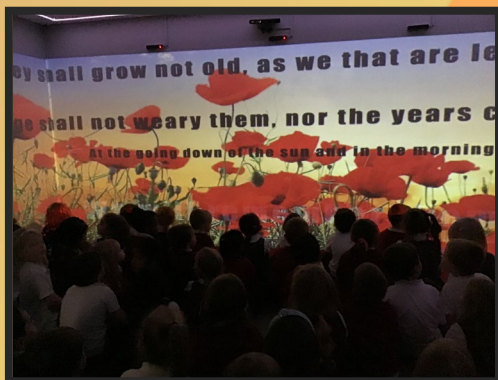
Examples of CULTURAL Development at WVPS:
