English English

As both readers and writers, we will be learning to retell stories using repeated refrains and creating our own stories using ones we have learnt as our inspiration. We will also be learning our sounds, being able to recognise, read and write them so others can recognise them.

Maths

As mathematicians, we will be subitising different arrangements, both unstructured and structured, including using the Hungarian number frame and making different arrangements of numbers within 5. We will talk about what we can see, to develop our conceptual subitising skills. We will also work on spotting smaller numbers 'hiding' inside larger numbers.

Science

As **scientists**, we will be learning about the life of dinosaurs on Earth. We will focus on when they were alive, and what they were like as living creatures.

Theme

As historians, we will be looking back into the past and exploring a time when dinosaurs lived on Earth. We will also be looking back in time at old stories which have shaped celebrations today.

As designers, we will be learning how to design and plan our ideas and turn these into our own creations.

As musicians, we will explore storytelling elements in the music and create a class story inspired by the piece. We will Identify and describe contrasts in tempo and dynamic and begin to use musical terms (louder/quieter, faster/slower, higher/lower).

As athletes, we will develop our skills in following instruction and playing team games. We will also develop some fundamental ball skills (throwing, catching and dribbling).
