As **writers**, we will be focusing on the story *The Koala Who Could* by Rachel Bright.

We will explore characters' thoughts and feelings, sequence events, and write a diary entry in role. We will focus on sentence structure, use of adjectives, correct punctuation, and writing in the past tense.

### Theme
