The sports premium is money given to the school by the Department for Education to improve the provision of sport and PE in primary schools in a sustainable way. It can only be spent on PE and Sport.

How the school has used this funding:

£2700	Specialist Coaching to each year group over the year	Enhanced skills training for all pupils from specialist coaches, teachers in attendance learning coaching skills for long term impact/sustainability.
£300	Tutor costs for additional swimming sessions	Increased percentage of children being able to swim 25m in Year 4 from 55% (2014) to 73% (2015).
£1800	Specialist Athletics coaching for Y6 over the year	Skilled preparation for Olympics event, children performed with confidence.

£750	Track hire and coach costs for cluster Olympics day at Bedford International Stadium	Enabled Y6 squad and spectators to partake in cluster Olympic competition at a professional stadium.
